

PATH Intl. Vaulting Faculty/Evaluator Process Checklist

Prerequisites

- Current PATH Intl. Interactive Vaulting Instructor
- Completion of Standards Course within last year
- Audit PATH Intl. Interactive Vaulting workshop and certification within last year
- Conduct 50 hours of group vaulting lessons (maximum of 25 as an AVA Instructor and minimum of 25 as a PATH Intl. Interactive Vaulting Instructor)

Apply

- Submit PATH Intl. Faculty Application with resume and 2 references from PATH Intl. faculty or PATH Intl. Interactive Vaulting Instructors
- Member of Interactive Vaulting Certification Subcommittee will contact applicant within 30 days to provide overview of process
 - Complete PATH Intl. General Faculty/Evaluator Training
- Upon written notification of approval from PATH Intl., proceed to Apprenticeship phase

Apprenticeship

(within 2 years of application approval)

- Complete Interactive Vaulting Specialty Faculty/Evaluator Training
- Obtain 2 passing performance evaluations from different Lead evaluators at Interactive Vaulting workshop and certification events held at different PACs (additional time to complete may be granted if there are not 2 suitable events within 2 years)
- Upon fulfillment of Apprenticeship requirements, PATH Intl. will confirm Associate status in writing*
 - Submit annual Faculty/Evaluator Compliance form

Associate

(within 2 years of Associate upgrade)

- Obtain 2 passing performance evaluations from different Lead evaluators at Interactive Vaulting workshop and certification events held at different PACs (additional time to complete may be granted if there are not 2 suitable events within 2 years)
- Upon fulfillment of Associate requirements, PATH Intl. will confirm Lead status in writing*
 - Submit annual Faculty/Evaluator Compliance form
 - Complete Faculty/Evaluator Training Refresher course as offered

Lead

- Submit annual instructor compliance form
- Submit annual Faculty/Evaluator compliance form
 - Complete mandatory webinars annually
- Complete performance evaluations of Apprentice and Associate Evaluators
 - Complete Faculty/Evaluator Training Refresher course as offered

* PATH Intl. will provide confirmation letters for advancement from Apprentice to Associate and Associate to Lead
PATH Intl. Programs and Education Department makes the final decision of the faculty appointed to teach PATH Intl. courses and perform PATH Intl. certification evaluations
