



PATH INTL. MEMBER CENTERS PILOTING or STARTING UP NEW PROGRAMS GRACE POLICY

All PATH Intl. Member Centers in good standing will be given 12 months to comply with all specialty requirements for a newly added program. All Premier Accredited and Center Members must complete a “Change Notification Form” and a “Progress Plan Form.” Once the 12-month grace period is over the PAC will need to meet and show compliance with all specialty standards. Then the PAC’s status will be reviewed and evaluated by the Accreditation Committee to decide if a re-visit is necessary. The center must continue to meet all core standards during the grace period. In the interim the center must meet Standard MA1* by having a PATH Intl. Certified Riding Instructor present as well as the Instructor-in-Training for the specialty activity during the time the specialty activity is taking place.
