



## Interactive Vaulting and Driving Survey Summary 2014

The **Interactive Vaulting** survey results from PATH Intl. member centers indicated that 70% do not offer this specialty to their participants due to lack of a certified vaulting instructor, proper horse or sufficient training. The remaining 30% have no interest in offering interactive vaulting.

When indicating why centers do not offer the Interactive Vaulting workshops, 25% cited lack of interest while 75% voiced concern regarding appropriate facility, horses, equipment, staff or resources.

The overarching theme from comments indicates the need for more education on the benefits of Interactive Vaulting and more accessibility to affordable trainings.

The **Driving** survey results indicated that 83% member centers do not offer this specialty to their participants due to lack of a certified instructor, proper horse, cart/equipment, sufficient facility/space or sufficient training. The remaining 17% have no interest in offering driving.

When indicating why centers do not offer Driving workshops or demonstrations, 30% cited lack of interest while 70% noted that they did not have the required facilities, horses, equipment, staff or resources.

The overarching theme from comments indicates the need for greater accessibility to affordable trainings and certifications and to consider lessening the certification requirements for individuals.
