



Recommended Universal PATH Intl. Faculty Requirements

Faculty Development Task Force

Effective January 1, 2015

It is recommended that all PATH Intl. Faculty requirements include the following minimum requirements:

- Current PATH Intl. member
- Complete and pass PATH Intl. Standards course or PATH Intl. Certified Instructor
- Complete PATH Intl. Faculty Course and any applicable specialty courses*
- Apprentice teach at least once under the direct supervision of an experienced faculty member in the discipline and ideally co-teach one time where possible
- Keep current in discipline through annual CEUs and faculty updates
- Renew annually to include signed code of ethics and availability to travel
- Application routed through PATH Intl. office and then sent to appropriate PATH Intl. Committee Chair.**

* When PATH Intl. Faculty Course becomes available

** PATH Intl. office will keep track of number of faculty applications coming in for each discipline, and the number of applicants that successfully pass the process to become faculty for each discipline. This information will be provided to the Education Oversight Committee (or other designated committee) to monitor potential problems with faculty pass rates or availability of enough faculty to meet future demand.
