I am a current PATH Intl. Individual Member		
I have obtained the PATH Intl. Registered Instructor Certification booklet from the PATH Intl. website and printed the doc of teaching hours form and the Horsemanship Skills Checklist		
I have read and understand all the requirements in the PATH Intl. Registered Instructor Certification booklet.		
I have completed all the documentation requirements outlined in the PATH Intl. Registered Instructor Certification booklet.		
I have current CPR and First Aid Certification and have sent a copy of both cards to the PATH Intl. office.		
I am 18 years of age or older.		
I have completed the CAT and the Self Study online exams.		
I meet ALL the Registered Instructor Criteria		
I have completed 25 hours of practice teaching to a group of 2 or more people with disabilities and have recorded them in the Documentation of Teaching Hours Form.		
I have completed or will soon complete two and a half day Registered Instructor Onsite Workshop within the last two years.		
I regularly reflect on and modify my instruction.		
I actively seek out continuing education to improve my skills.		
I am within the time line outlined for completion of each segment of the process as listed in the PATH Intl. Registered Instructor Certification booklet.

I have located an onsite certification to attend.		
I have received or plan to receive my Instructor in Training letter from the PATH Intl. office prior to attending my on-site certification.
