## Explanation of Income and Expenses:

Each student will be responsible for keeping up with his/her money that will be used continuously towards a budget throughout the 9 week program. **Money must be brought to each class; this will be part of your participation!** Money will be earned and spent according to the above chart and at the discretion of the instructors.

Students will get \$75 each time they show up to school and come to STAR. Other sources of income (activity participation, helping others, answering questions and completing assigned tasks) can be earned throughout the class and will be determined by attitude and willingness to learn.

Students will also have daily and weekly expenses. **Board and feed/hay are fixed expenses that will be collected on the first class day of every month.** Farrier and de-worming fees apply and will be collected the first Friday following service. Vet bills and supplies are considered miscellaneous expenses and will be determined on an individual basis for basic horse care. Further, students will be deducted “pay” for having an unexcused school absence or for not bringing their money to class.
