PATH INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION PROCESS:

PHASE TWO (PATH CONTINUED)

PATH offers three levels of Instructor Certification for therapeutic riding: Registered, Advanced and Master. The focus of this workshop/certification is the Registered Level.

In order to become a PATH Certified Instructor, you must successfully complete the two Phases of the certification process. For additional Information on this process, please refer to the PATH website at www.pathintl.org under *Instructor Information box*.

Any questions that you have regarding Phase One should be directed to the PATH office, and questions regarding Phase Two should be directed to *Good Hope Equestrian Training Center, Inc.*

PHASE ONE (PATH)

Upon submission of the Registered Instructor Application Form, an application fee, copies of current Adult & Child CPR and First Aid certification cards, and PATH Intl. membership number or application to PATH Intl. office, you will officially enter into Phase One. Upon receipt PATH Intl. will e-mail you Phase One Instructions. These instructions include access to the following online components:

- Instructor Self Study Course.
- Standards Course.
- Pre-Certification Self-Assessment.

• **Note: Candidates** have 12 months to complete the Phase One Packet. Please note the CAT Course has a 60-day timeframe and the Instructor Self Study Course has a 180 day timeframe.

Upon successful completion of Phase One, you will receive a confirmation of Instructor-in-Training status via email from the PATH Intl. office. At this point, a candidate is considered a **PATH INTL. instructor-in-training**. You may retain this designation for **12 months** from the date of the confirmation letter.

PHASE TWO (PATH)

Within the 12-month timeframe, you must complete all the components of Phase Two:

*Complete 25 hours of practice teaching group mounted therapeutic riding lessons under the guidance or direct supervision of a PATH Certified Instructor.

*Attend a Registered Instructor On-Site Workshop. PRIOR is attending a Registered Certification course.

*Successfully complete a Registered Instructor On-Site Certification

If you would like to attend the On-Site Workshop and Certification, please complete the attached form and mail with the appropriate fees to the address listed.

You will also need to include a copy of your confirmation of Instructor-in-Training status letter from Phase One, if registering for the Certification.

Candidates are registered on a first come-first served basis, so make sure to register early. *All Certification Candidates must register 32 days prior to Registered Certification (February 29th, 2020.)*

Once registered for the workshop, GHETC will send you a Phase Two Packet containing:

- *On-site registered form.
- *Emergency Medical Treatment, Liability, and Confidentiality forms.
- *Documentation of teaching hours form.
- *Additional forms for certification candidates: instructor resume, personal reference, professional reference, essay questions.

You will need to complete the Phase Two Packet and return to GHETC with a copy of your PATH membership card and current copies of your CPR and First Aid certification. All Phase Two forms must be returned to GHETC *no later than March 23rd, 2020.*
