In order to become a PATH Intl. certified instructor, you must successfully complete the two Phases of the Registered Certification process. For more information, please visit www.pathintl.org.

Phase I

With the submission of the Registered Instructor Certification Application Form, a \$75 application fee, copies of current CPR and First Aid Certification, and PATH Intl. member number, you will enter Phase One and will receive a packet containing access to the following components:

- Center Accreditation Training Course
- Instructor CAT Exam
- Instructor Self-Study Course
- Registered Instructor open book exam

* Phase I must be completed within 12 months of submitting application. Upon completion of above components and submission of the Equine Management Skills Checklist, you will receive your IT (Instructor In Training) letter and may continue to Phase 2.

Phase 2

Within 12 months of receiving your IT letter, you must complete 25 hours of mentored hours with a PATH Intl. Certified Riding professional and attend a PATH Intl. On-Site Workshop and Certification

* It is optional to attend a workshop and begin your mentored teaching hours before you receive your IT letter, but certification cannot be completed until after you receive this. If you attempt to complete the certification without the IT letter, you will be charged a penalty fee.

For Certification:

Include a copy of your Instructor-In-Training Letter

* If **only** registering for the certification, add a copy of Certificate of attendance to an approved PATH Intl. instructor certification workshop within the previous year.

Once registered for the workshop and/or Certification, Horsepower Inc. will send you a **Phase Two Packet**. This packet will include the following information:

- On-Site Registration Form
- Additional forms for certification candidates: Resume, personal and professional references, essay questions
- Emergency Medical Treatment, Liability, and Confidentiality Forms
- Documentation of Teaching Hours Form

You will need to complete the Phase Two packet and return to Horsepower with a copy of you PATH Intl. membership card, and current copies of your CPR and First Aid Certification.

All Phase Two Forms must be returned to Horsepower at least 32 days prior to the Registered Certification.
